- SISNET aspires to engage with the broader public and generate accessible information and foster debate on Iraq and Nordic-Iraqi relations through public events, cultural activities and establishing contacts with the media.
- · SISNET supports research, seminars, and international collaborations
- SISNET collaborates with Swedish and Nordic universities that have a strong focus on lraq and intends to promote relevant academic interest.

- SISNET is hosted by the Center for Middle Eastern Studies (CMES) of Lund University.
