It is derived from the program description Program Vision: An ambitious picture for the future of the academic program to .be a developed, inspiring, motivating, realistic and applicable programme explains the objectives and activities necessary to Program message: It briefly .achieve them, and also identifies the program's development paths and directions Program objectives: These are statements that describe what the academic program intends to achieve within a specific period of time and are measurable .and observable

<u>Curriculum structure:</u> All courses/study subjects included in the academic program according to the approved learning system (semester, annual, Bologna track), whether it is a requirement (ministry, university, college, or scientific .department), along with the number of study units
